Volunteer Engagement and

Management Program - *volunteer recruitment, referral and management, and tailored volunteer workshops and training.*

Community Visitors Scheme - *A free visitor program for elderly people who experience loneliness and social isolation by connecting with the local community.*

Migrant Support Service - *Provides information & assistance for migrants and refugees as well as service providers.*

Learner Driver Program

This program aims to help new drivers gain more experience and become skilled and safer drivers.

Counselling services - *low fee high quality counselling for trauma, addiction and relational issues. Tuesdays and Wednesdays 9am-1pm*

Legal Advice Clinic - *civil, criminal and family legal advice*
Thursday, 10 am - 2pm

Form Help - *a service provided to assist with letter writing and filling out forms*
Tuesdays, 9.30am - 1.30pm

Tax Help - *assistance to people in genuine need, to help them comply with their tax obligations at tax time. Runs from August to the end of October.*
